

## Cape Wildfires Answers

#### Before a Wildfire

Find out if you are in a wildfire **prone** area.

Have sprinklers and a **hose pipe** available that can reach all around your house in a place that is easy to access.

Have a **fire evacuation** plan put in place and practice **fire drills** with your family.

Make sure all family members know "**stop, drop and roll**" in case their clothes catch fire.

Have an **emergency kit** available in your house and your **car**.

Stay **informed** on the latest emergency updates in your area.

Have **fire resistant** foliage around your home.

Check around your home for any **fire hazards** that could be fuel to a wildfire.

Have an **emergency plan** in place where family members how how to contact each other if you get separated.

#### During a Wildfire

Keep your <u>lights on</u> inside your home to help you see if smoke gets in.

Stay **informed** on the latest emergency updates in your area.

Keep windows and doors **closed**.

If you leave your home, **tell someone** and let him or her know where your are going.

If an evacuation is in effect, leave immediately with **protective clothing** on and choose a safe path without fire hazards.

#### After a Wildfire

**Stay away** from the wildfire until it is safe to return.
